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
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### The Intro

## CONTENT ACCESSED BY CHILDREN:

Our children from Chudar centre and students at Govt. Schools, after the lockdown, accessed the following list of videos, worksheets/ puzzles (WS/P) and assessments as shown in the table beside:

#### - A SCHOOL PROGRESS:

The Govt. Higher Secondary School at Katthivakkam faced huge student dropouts, as low as 9 students per group, while adapting to the WhatsApp mode of teaching.

Our coordinators engaged with the faculties of the school to understand the problem at hand and suggested effective ways of engaging the students through our worksheets (including home assignments) and videos to aid in improving the teaching experience using these web tools. We encouraged students directly and through their teachers to participate in different subject groups which led improved participation all the way to 31 students per group.

"My experience with Chudar has been wonderful. I thoroughly enjoyed my stint here and learned a lot over a short span of time. I firmly believe that education has no boundaries. Everyone deserves a chance to gain knowledge and be educated. Learning need not be confined to school and can take place anywhere and at any age.

My first session was with a student of Class Eight and was extremely engaging. I truly enjoyed helping her with spoken English.

Although she struggled a lot initially, she was very keen and determined to learn the language. Despite her difficulty, she retained a positive frame of mind; an outlook that I think is integral for success. Due to the pandemic, I was not able to meet her in person and had to conduct all the sessions through phone calls. However, I was able to establish a good rapport with her, and we proceeded beyond small-talk and shared personal stories. At this point, I realized that some of our experiences were quite similar, notwithstanding the differences in our backgrounds. This helped me gain her trust and bond better with her. She told me "Akka, you're my first friend," and this hit me hard as it was surreal to hear something like that from a thirteen-year-old. This journey of Education Empowerment with Chudar has been an enriching experience. I feel a sense of accomplishment for having taken baby steps towards improving the education of the underprivileged."
