



This academic year we restarted our physical centres after having them entirely online during the pandemic. The pandemic had seen a loss in learning, but we overcame that hurdle through a combination of online and in-person classes. Our after-school program expanded to 50 villages and 9 centers in urban areas. We launched Chudar Champs, a program to bridge the STEM gap for girls through hands-on experiments and activities. We have incorporated the learnings from this initiative into the statewide Vanavil Mandram program to improve STEM skills in middle

statewide **Vanavil Mandram** program to improve STEM skills in middle school students. We are happy that more than **55 volunteers** were able to visit our centers and motivate the children during the past few months.

Among them were 15 IITM scholars who, as a part of a 'Women in Leadership' course, visited some of our villages and inspired the students.

Chudar currently brings about measurable improvement in learning outcomes to more than 5500 children. In addition, our partnership with the state government enables our content and methodologies to reach a million children in government schools across Tamil Nadu.
