Our founder, Dr. Ravishankar, spoke at a conference on 'Teaching Thinking and Thinking of Teaching' organised by the Centre for Intrinsic Motivation. His thoughts were on 'The Role of Teachers in Improving Learning Outcomes'.



Dr. Ravi pointed out that teachers often feared higher officials, as they would find fault with them for low learning outcomes of students. In an environment where there large-scale gaps in learning, he emphasized that the education system and officials should instead give autonomy to teachers on the ways to improve it.
